1. **Welcome and Introductions.** Liane welcomed everyone in attendance and made introductions.
2. **Correspondence.** Jaimie Morton sent Thank You cards to the chairpersons for Teacher Appreciation Week, Fishing Derby, and to Kim Rutter for Boxtops. Several Thank You notes were received from the teachers for Teacher Appreciation Week.
3. **Approval of Minutes.** April minutes were approved.
4. **Treasurers Report.** The checkbook has a balance of \$6073.19 and an available balance of \$7472.17. The difference is \$1398.98 which is made from outstanding checks and our district reimbursement. We received profits from a Jewel Shop and Share and the Mother/Daughter Tea. The treasurer made several motions to reallocate money from one category to another category. The motions were to reallocate \$150 from the Character Counts category to the Assemblies category, reallocate \$326.23 from the Unplugged category to the Assemblies category, and reallocate \$15.77 from Miscellaneous to the Assemblies category and \$13.90 from Miscellaneous to Teacher Appreciation category. There were no objections and Lora Lafin made a motion to approve and Dan Simpson made a second motion. The board approved the changes. The treasurer presented next year's budget and Lora made a motion to approve and Dave Leatherwood made a second motion. The board approved the proposed budget.
5. **2007-2008 Fundraisers/Events**
 - **Box Tops for Education & Tyson A+ Labels** – The last date for turning in tops was 4/30. The winners are as follows: Mrs. Beseth, Mrs. Amish, and Mrs. Micetich AM & PM. The winners receive an extra recess, a healthy snack and a water bottle.
 - **Kemps Milk Tops-From Starbucks** – We have currently collected 43,515 caps. The last check collected was for \$466.00 and our total this year was \$1723.89. We need a co-chair for next year.

- **Year End Picnic** – This is an all day event scheduled for 5/30 with a Hula theme. This event requires at least 125 volunteers. Debbie Diekevers is the main chairperson and we need many mini-chairpersons.
- **Bus Driver Appreciation Brunch** – The date is scheduled for 5/21 and Christina Wiseman is the chairperson. She will be contacting people for help.
