#### **1. District Social Fundraiser**

Theresa Herstowski, Maureen Gibbons and David Leatherwood are this years Chairpersons. The date for the event is Sunday, March 16th, 2008. The movie for the event is: "Horton Hears A Who", rated G. We have secured a second theater as ticket sales are anticipated to be great. Having 2 theaters will provide for 380 people to watch the movie. Ticket Sales have begun this week and sales have been brisk, over 100 sold with 4 weeks remaining prior to the event. Donations are still being collected and organized. The Silent Auction will be open on the District Web Page by the end of next week (Feb 25-Feb29). The Auction will close on the district's site on Saturday, March 15<sup>th</sup> at 3pm. The participants at the event will be able to bid on those Silent Auction items prior to the movie. There will be a 5\$ Raffle that will be sent out to the families within the district for 3 top prizes which will also start Monday Feb 25<sup>th</sup>. Nadine Bahaveolos and Ellen Barton will chair the raffle portion of the event. Tickets to the event and raffle tickets will be on sale at Market Day Saturday Feb 23<sup>rd</sup>. There will be some baskets at the event for the children which will be \$2.00 each. Face Painting by the teachers/principals and other entertainment will be at the event prior to the movie's start. Donations from business and families continue to come into the district. Sponsorship of the event is also offered to both business and families who can not attend but wish to participate.

#### **2. Market Day**
