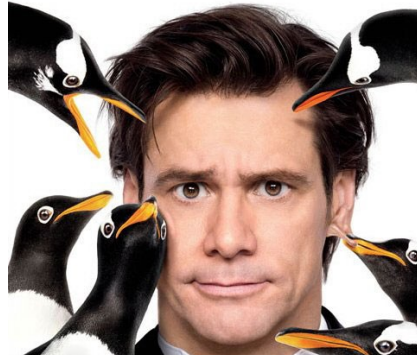

- 1. The movie will be shown at Prairieview and will be available to Prairieview students only. Students may bring pillows and sleeping bags to sit on during the movie.**
- 2. The hours for Movie Night are 6:30 p.m. to 8:45 p.m. Students should be dropped off no earlier than 6:30. No admittance will be allowed after the movie begins at 6:45.**
- 3. There will be an intermission during the movie in which the students will be provided with a drink and snack. No food or drink may be brought to this event from home.**
- 4. Please be prompt in picking up your child. The school needs to be locked up for cleaning.**
- 5. Emergency numbers are mandatory. In the event of illness or misconduct, we must be able to reach a parent or guardian. Students are expected to display good behavior so others may enjoy the movie.**
