

Parent/Student Back-To-School Survey Questions

(75% of students responded – 817 students out of 1086 verified enrollment last year)

1. Students attending D66 need to wear a mask and social distance. Students who are immunocompromised can provide D66 a doctor's note and an alternative model will be provided. Select the Status of Your Child's Schooling Situation
 - a. My child will be attending school in person on August 20th and is not immunocompromised
 - b. My child will be attending school in person on August 20th, is immunocompromised, and needs in-school accommodations
 - c. My child will not be attending in person, is immunocompromised, and will provide a doctor's note for an alternative model from D66
 - d. My child will not be attending in person, will not have a doctor's note for being immunocompromised, and I would like another option besides in-school learning to attend D66

2. Parents of students in D66 will need to self certify every day at Elizabeth Ide before 7:00 am, at Prairieview before 7:30 am, and at Lakeview before 7:45 am that their child is COVID-19 symptom free and has not come into contact with someone who is COVID-19 positive. Which best describes your ability to self-certify your student?

 - b. Yes, I can self certify using the internet to complete a 4 question Google Form each morning but I am in need of a thermometer

 - d. Yes, I could self certify but I am in need of a thermometer and the internet to complete the Google Form
 - e. No, I am not attending, therefore, it is necessary for me to complete the Google Form
