



RESIDENCY VERIFICATION
2018-2019

This year District 66 will be using an electronic information verification system to automatically verify **current** student address information. If your residency is electronically verified, you will not receive any notifications and will not need to provide anything further. We anticipate that the overwhelming majority of our current families will be electronically verified.

If, however, we are unable to electronically verify that the student's home address lies within the district's boundaries, we will make every effort to contact you by June 8 so that you can provide additional information by July 1, 2018 in order to register your child for the upcoming school year.

Verifying residency is an effort to protect taxpayers and district resources by identifying non-residents who are attending district schools. Illinois law mandates that parents demonstrate residency prior to enrollment in school and allows for periodic verification to validate compliance with the law.
