How will my donation be used?

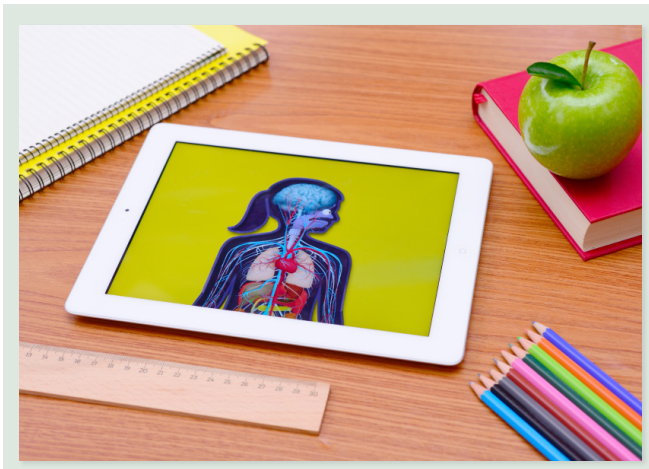
Your donation will be distributed in the form of grants to teachers in District 66.
